 The **Arc of St. Charles** assisted in grocery deliveries and pharmacy pickups for the elderly and those considered immunocompromised.

 In partnership with **Second Harvest, St. Charles Parish Public Schools** distributed more than **3,600 meal kits** for students during the stay-at-home order.

 In response to growing demands, we increased funding for emergency needs, such as rental and utility assistance, in partnership with **Catholic Charities**.

  The **American Red Cross** stayed on track with hurricane preparation by promoting **The Pillowcase Project** virtually, as well as donating more than **200 cleanup kits** and gift cards after the recent floods.

 We sponsored the **St. Charles Tutoring Lab** to provide stay-at-home learning support in all subject areas to students in St. Charles Parish.
