LIVING UNITED

RESPOND



UWSC was part of the **St. Charles Parish Emergency Operations Center's activation team**, referring residents to and providing resources before, during, and after Ida's immediate impact.



Within 72 hours of Ida's landfall, staff developed **two websites** to solicit volunteers and match them with residents' needs.



The Valero River Parishes Community College UWSC Campus in Boutte became a **hub of activity**, with space for **supplies, food from regional food banks, staff, equipment, volunteer housing, and trailer distribution**. UWSC helped stock more than **12 parish distribution sites**.



UWSC, in partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank, distributed about **285,000 pounds of supplies**, including **food, water, cleaning supplies, baby items, and pet food**.



UWSC partner agency Second Harvest's Community Kitchen made **hot, cold, and shelf-stable meals** delivered to National Guard sites.

RECOVER



Three faith-based crisis groups responded through UWSC, helping clean up immediately after Ida. These efforts will continue throughout 2022.

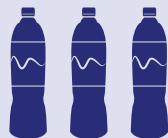


UWSC activated a **pool of case workers** through a partner agency to field residents' calls for assistance.




FEMA

FEMA set up an office to interact with residents at the Valero River Parishes Community College UWSC Campus.



UWSC helped **solicit, acquire, and distribute donated supplies** from industry partners and the community, including **water, drinks, generators, fuel, emergency radios, hygiene supplies, food, tarps, clothing, baby supplies, boxes, trash bags, and more**.

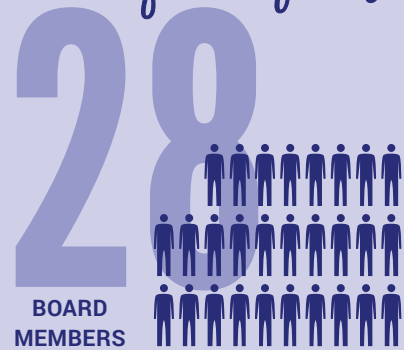
