FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (SBA)

Everyone fully expects Louisiana's "SBA Declared Disaster" request to be approved within the next 72 hours. The approved declaration for Louisiana will be found at https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela/Declarations/Index. Businesses and non-profits will then be able to apply to the SBA for an *Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL)*. Businesses and non-profits learn details and can apply bv visiting https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela/Information/EIDLLoans. We recommend that impacted business owners/operators begin to familiarize themselves with the application requirements in order to shorten the processing timeline.

REGIONAL SMALL BUSINESS LOANS

Our regional small business loan programs continue to be available to local businesses. Loans can be used for working capital and funds carry a 4% interest rate. We are working with our partner and loan administrator, South Central Planning & Development Commission, to develop a streamlined process to accommodate the short-term economic damages resulting from this crisis.
